

## Chaîne des Rôtisseurs Members' Guide

## Organization

Membership of the Chaîne is by invitation only and generally on the recommendation of a member. Once an application is approved, the new member will be invited to attend activities in his or her local Bailliage or chapter.

New members are formally inducted at an annual gala, which must be presided over by at least one regional or national officer.

Members generally wear ribbons, awards and regalia at these and many other events, which denote their level of membership and past and present accomplishments within the organization.

A full list of these titles and ribbons is illustrated on our US website (*see back page*).

Those selected to be officers wear special ribbons, with the color designating either operating rank (green) or administrative rank (blue).

Officers' ribbons are edged with gold braid indicating national service, or silver braid indicating regional service.



A *Bailli*, assisted by a board of officers, manages the affairs of a *Bailliage*. A *Bailli Provincial* manages a region.

Regional officers are part of a National Council. A board of national officers is presided over by a *Bailli Délégue*.

Baiili Délégues from around the world are part of an international council that convenes in Paris, where the organization has its world headquarters.
